PENNSYLVANIA GOLF CLUB TO BE THE FIRST SOLAR POWERED COURSE IN THE STATE

*Advanced Solar Industries, LLC installs 1,320 solar panels to power
Foxchase Golf Club*

DENVER, Pa (July 14, 2010) – This summer, sunshine is providing more than just pleasant rays for golfers at Foxchase Golf Club in Central Pennsylvania. Sunshine, through the technology of solar panels, will be powering the golf course beginning in late summer, early fall. Advanced Solar Industries, LLC will perform the solar installation.

Foxchase is believed to be the only golf course in Pennsylvania powered by solar energy. The system at the golf course covers an acre of land and is composed of 1,320 solar panels. The system is expected to produce 360 mega watts of power per year, about the same amount of electricity used to power 30 homes.

The State and Federal government encourage the use of alternative energy sources through a variety of incentives like the Renewable Energy Tax Credit and the Pennsylvania Sunshine Solar program. The system at Foxchase qualifies for accelerated depreciation under those programs and there is an expected 5 year payback on the system.

At the time of agreement, about half the costs of the system were offset by Federal and State incentives. The system is expected to yield a positive cash flow of \$144,000 annually.

“Foxchase has the opportunity to experience almost 100% energy independence and significantly reduce their carbon footprint after installing a solar energy system, “ said ASI CEO Josh Mitten. “The system at Foxchase is going to offset approximately 7.2 million pounds of carbon or 3,600 tons of carbon per year.”

The system, wired underground, can be monitored anywhere in the world via an Internet connection. A display mounted in the course’s Pro Shop will provide the public with live updates about the amount of solar power being produced, as well as the impact of the system on the environment.

“Foxchase aims to stay in the forefront of the golf industry,” said Foxchase Co-owner Steve Graybill. “Utilizing solar technology is a welcomed addition to both our course and the community.”
